

Questionnaire A – Users (of services that target private individuals/households)

This survey was developed within the framework of the Swedish KOMPIS project (Work Package 4). The survey is a 'baseline survey', designed to be answered by customers / users of combined mobility services which target private individuals / households.

The survey should be digitised using a suitable web tool. It is up to each pilot to select and create web surveys, but it is important to select a tool that (i) provides the required question and answer formats, (ii) which can provide output in SPSS format, and (iii) that meets the requirements of the EU Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This questionnaire (Questionnaire A), must be answered by (potential) customers / users before they start using the combined mobility service. The questionnaire aims to generate data about: 1) individuals' travel behavior prior to trialling combined mobility, with a focus on everyday travel; 2) reasons for modal choices; and 3) expectations regarding combined mobility. A second questionnaire, (Questionnaire B), must be answered when the customer / user has used the service for a longer period. Quesionnaire B includes further questions about travel behavior and modal choices to elucidate ways in which access to combined mobility services influences everday travel behavior.

The intention is to collect responses from many pilots and trials that test different combined mobility services. The resulting pool of data will be uploaded to a national database. In order to ensure comparability between data from different pilots, <u>questions and response options must not be removed nor changed</u>. However, more questions and response options may be added as necessary.

These questionnaires, along with those which target service providers and municipalities / regions, are under development. We intend to gradually improve them to promote the creation of robust data and to ensure as little dropout as possible. We are thus interested in dialogues with pilot owners and researchers who will use these questionnaires on how to improve the formulation of questions and answers.
